General Rules

1. All general rules and regulations for the Madison County Fair apply to this department with the exceptions as noted below.
2. This is an open “youth” show with ages calculated as of September 30, 2009. Sub-juniors are less than 9, juniors are 9-11, intermediates are 12-13, and seniors are 14-18. **These age groups may be adjusted at the desecration of the department head depending on the number of entries received.** Novice classes are for those exhibitors who are new to the project or this is their first year in the showring.
3. Exhibitors do not have to own their entries but should be responsible for the primary training of the animals exhibited.
4. Only one entry per youth may be exhibited in any class.
5. Animals should be on the fairgrounds by 8:30 AM, Saturday, July 18.
6. Although not a sanctioned show, it will be judged by the standards presented in Alpaca and Llama Show Association (ALSA) Handbook, 15th Edition.
7. Premiums for each class will be 1st-\$12, 2nd-\$10, 3rd-\$8, 4th-\$6, 5th-\$4, 6th-\$2. Ribbons will be awarded for 1st through 6th place along with participation ribbons.
8. **There is no entry fee nor premiums paid for the sub-junior classes.** Ribbons will be awarded.
9. Rosettes will be presented to the Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion in each division: junior, intermediate, and senior. Points will be determined by the number of exhibitors in each class and then combined from points earned in showmanship and performance. The placing in the showmanship class will be the tiebreaker if necessary.
10. Gambler’s Choice: Handler and llama will have 60 seconds to race around and do as many obstacles as they can while collecting points. A whistle will be blown, and you will then have 15 seconds to complete a bonus obstacle to earn extra points. All entry fee money from this class will be divided as premium money, with 1st place earning 50% of the “pot”, 2nd place earning 30%, and 3rd place receiving 20%.
11. Please use the attached entry form.
12. Entry fee is \$5 per class for classes 2-7 and 9-15.
13. All entries are due to the department head or Madison Extension Office by 4:30 PM, **July 10, 2009.**
14. As time allows several “fun” classes may be added such as Leaping Llama, Limbo Llama or a parent’s performance class. There will be no entry fee or premiums paid, but prizes will be awarded. Contact department head for further information.
