## Madison County Fair General Rules and Regulations

---

1. All general rules and regulations apply to visitors, patrons, exhibitors, vendors, and any other persons on the Fair Grounds at the Madison County Fair. The Fair Board reserves the right to interpret or change these rules and regulations without notice.
2. No animals are allowed on the Fair Grounds other than pre-registered animals in Fair events and shows, or service animals (registered with proper attire). Livestock entries are prohibited from leaving the assigned livestock area during the fair. Any unruly animals will not be allowed on the Grounds and their removal will be requested immediately.
3. Shirts and shoes are required on the Fair Grounds. This is a family event, and visitors should dress appropriately. Violators will be asked to leave the Grounds.
4. No tents or objects that will obstruct the view of others will be allowed in the track event seating area. No roping of areas is permitted. Chairs and blankets may be used to save space.
5. No coolers are permitted on the Grounds. The only exception will be medical supply coolers and livestock exhibitors who must keep their coolers in the barn area. Coolers are subject to being searched at any time.
6. All visitors and exhibitors must be off the Grounds within one-half hour after the slated Grounds closing time (see Daily Schedule). Exhibitors will not be allowed to stay overnight on the Fair Grounds.
7. No alcohol, drugs, or weapons of any kind are permitted on the Grounds, including parking areas.
8. No disruptive behavior will be tolerated on the Grounds. This includes physical fighting, inappropriate verbal fighting, and conduct the Fair Board deems disruptive. Fair Board members will ask individuals involved in such conduct to leave the Grounds immediately.
9. The Madison County Fair Board is not responsible for loss or damages to any personal property of visitors, patrons, exhibitors, vendors, or any other persons on the Fair Grounds, including the parking areas.
10. Only Fair Board members can drive and designate licensed individuals to operate any vehicles leased by the Fair Board.
11. Fair Board members have the right to enforce these rules and regulations. Any violation of these rules can result in the removal from the Grounds.
