

## SECTION Q: QUILTS

**\*\* Classes have been updated for 2022. Entries are grouped according to finished sizes, to recognize the effort and skill required between small and large items. Please note the changes. \*\***

### SECTION RULES

1. All general rules apply.
2. Articles must be the work of the person in whose name they are entered. A group project (raffle quilt, round robins) may be entered as long as it is entered in the name of a group or participants.
3. Quilt must have been completed in the past two years, but must not have been entered previously in this Fair.
4. Only one entry per exhibitor per class. *(check sewing & craft classes for other possible entries)*
5. Entries are judged on design, appearance, workmanship, and suitability of materials.
6. All quilts must be labeled with: hand quilted by (fill in name)\_\_\_\_\_, home machine quilted by (fill in name)\_\_\_\_\_, or commercially quilted by (fill in name)\_\_\_\_\_ on the entry tag.

Q-01 Small quilted projects - May include, but are not limited to the following:

Postcard	pillow	potholder	Christmas item: stocking, ornament, tree skirt
Table runner	name badge	placemat	

Q-02 Miniature quilts – not to exceed 25” on longest side

Q-03 Small quilts – 26” to 45” on longest side

Q-04 Medium quilts – 46” to 65” on longest side

Q-05 Large quilts – over 66” on longest side

***There will be NEW Special Rosettes, for Best Use of Color/Design, Best Hand Quilted, Best Home Machine Quilted, Best Commercial Quilted, Best Hand Applique, Best Machine Applique, chosen from all entries. The Best of Show and Viewer’s Choice winners will receive gift cards. The Special Quilting Awards are sponsored by the Madison Quilter’s Guild.***
